NOMINATIONS PACKET

Fellowship: The fellowship is a \$24,000.00 (\$2,000/month) stipend for a period of up to one year, an allocation of \$2,676.00 to purchase graduate student health insurance if requested, and payment of \$6552.00 in tuition (but not fees) for up to 24 credit hours (9 Fall, 9 Spring, and 6 Summer). Fellows can apply for a Professional development Grant for up to \$1,000.00 for expenses, such as travel to a meeting, workshop, short course, registration, visit another lab to learn techniques, unique educational activity, etc. as recommended by the Chair of the Graduate Advisory Committee and approved by the Chair of the Tom Slick Committee. The grant cannot be used to defray travel or expenses related to the student's dissertation research. This yields a total package of up to \$34,228.00
