Fellows can apply for a Professional development Grant for up to \$1,000.00 for expenses, such as travel to a meeting, workshop, short course, registration, visit another lab to learn techniques, unique educational activity, etc. as recommended by the Chair of the Graduate Advisory Committee and approved by the Chair of the Tom Slick Committee. The grant cannot be used to defray travel or expenses related to the student's dissertation research. This yields a total package of up to \$34,228.00
